Residential Waste Disposal and Ordinance Information

The City of Cleveland Division of Waste Collection and Disposal is committed to providing an efficient and thorough residential waste collection service. The citizens of this City can help ensure the safety of the men and women of Waste Collection by complying with the following regulations:

- All waste containers should be in good condition to hold waste. Refuse in any waste container shall NOT exceed **70 pounds** in weight.
- Residential waste containers should not be set out prior to noon the day before collection. Waste containers should be returned to original storage place within **12 hours** after pickup.
- Bulk Items such as discarded furniture, tree trunks, large brush, and appliances are special waste pickups. Other items that are too large to be put in the containers should be bundled. Wood, branches, and other material should be cut no longer than **3 feet** in length, **24 inches** in diameter and should not exceed **100 pounds**. Carpeting shall be cut, rolled and bundled into **4 foot** lengths.
- High volume trash on your collection day **must be properly contained** once it's set out for pick up.
- In case of an eviction the property owner **will be charged a fine** for removal of excessive bulk items and unbundled refuse set out on the tree lawn.
- To avoid contaminated recyclables rinse recyclable items before disposing
- Please **SLOW DOWN** and **LOOK OUT** when passing a Waste Collection vehicle!

Waste Citations and Collection Enforcement Procedure

Municipal Code	Description
551.02	Failure to provide approved waste container(s).
551.04	Placement of solid waste out for collection prior to noon on the day preceding regular waste collection.
551.04b	Failure to remove waste containers from the front of property within 12 hours after collection.
551.06	Failure to provide sufficient residential waste containers.
551.07	Failure to properly wrap and /or store garbage.
551.08	Failure to prevent and /or discontinue the scattering of solid waste.
551.111	Evictions of large set outs.
551.05	Placement of oversized and/or overweight items. Items exceeding 100 pounds in weight.
551.15	Deposit of dead animal carcass as a solid waste.
