Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update

Tuesday, February 6, 2018

Dominion East Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project – PIR 2114
Osage Avenue & Broadway Avenue
(City of Cleveland Ward 12)

Expect additional traffic notices as work progresses

CLEVELAND – On Tuesday, February 6, 2018 Dominion East Ohio Gas Company will begin a pipeline infrastructure improvement project which includes work on the following street:

- Osage Avenue – From Broadway Avenue to East 78th Street.

The project scope is to replace the old steel mainline with new plastic mainline in the sidewalk area. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times on Osage Avenue with traffic control personnel in the work zone(s) directing traffic. Access to adjacent driveways will be maintained throughout construction and the work will take place Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

This project is expected to be completed by mid-February. Temporary, 2” thick sidewalk will be installed until permanent sidewalk can be installed in the spring. Final grading and landscaping will immediately follow the permanent sidewalk installation.
